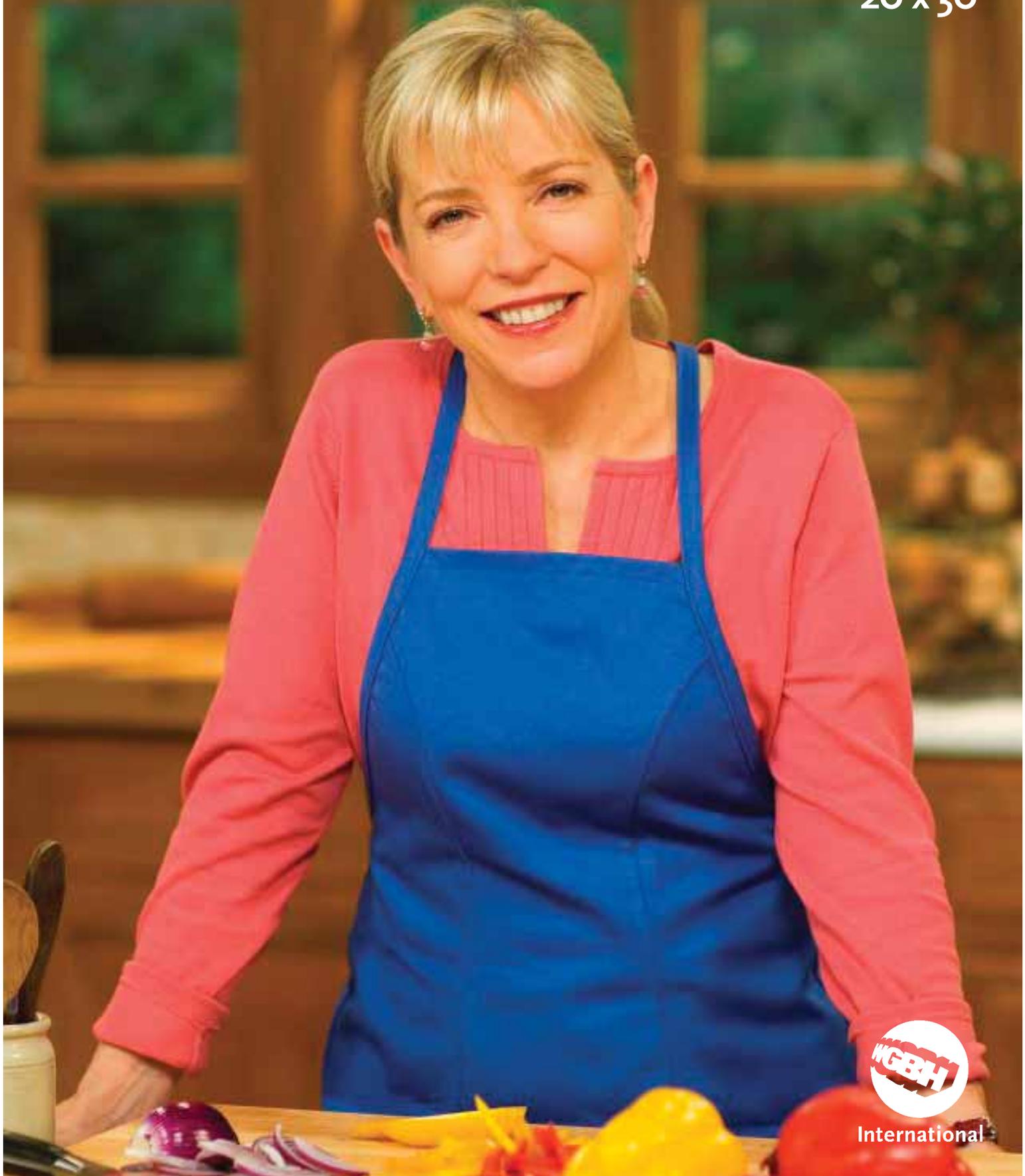


Sara's *weeknight* Meals
