In 1952, a young Egyptian colonel named Gamal Abdel Nasser led a coup that became a revolution, winning the support of millions of his countrymen. Over the next 18 years he challenged Western hegemony abroad, confronted Islamic fervor at home, established the region's first military authoritarian regime and faced deep divisions among Egyptians. A man of enormous charisma and ambition, Nasser died at 52 with his dreams of a new Egypt in tatters. *Nasser's Republic: The Making of Modern Egypt* traces how he gave the Arab world a new way to see itself, while also confronting the legacy that he left behind.
